
## Take a Nature Walk & Build an Owl Nest!

Take a walk or just spend some time in your yard. Your child can collect twigs, leaves, feathers, grass, weeds, etc.

Then your child can use the natural items they've gathered to build a bird's nest, just like how they helped the owl in *This is Owl* build a nest!
