





## UW Move In Week Could Affect Dropoff



**WHAT:** Due to UW campus move-in week, Boat Street will be closed between 15th Ave NE and NE Pacific Street.

**WHEN:** This week, from Tuesday, Sept. 16 through Friday, Sept. 19.

### HOW COULD THIS AFFECT YOU?

There are often long lines of UW families waiting to get onto Boat Street, causing extra traffic and slower commutes. Please plan on some longer commute times.

For families who bus, this week could see longer commute times into school and later dropoff times in the afternoon.

## Picking Up and Dropping Off

### Picking up and Dropping off:

When dropping off or picking up your child at regular times, you may simply proceed to the classrooms. We invite families to head back to the classrooms at 8:35 in the morning. In the afternoon you can go at 2:55 (or 1:40 on Wednesdays). If you arrive early you are more than welcome to wait in our lobby.

### Coming to school for another reason:

If you will be spending an extended time at school:

- to attend a meeting,
- to spend time in the observation booth
- or to volunteer in your child's class

We ask that you sign in on the white Visitor Sign-In sheet at the office and wear a visitor badge for the duration of your stay. When you leave you will sign out and return your badge. We appreciate your help keeping all of our students safe. (\*\*your QR parking code only covers the 30 minutes of pick-up or drop-off. If you intend to stay longer, you will need to secure another parking option\*\*)

### Picking up a child before dismissal time:

We understand that many different sorts of events and appointments happen during the school day and that families need the flexibility to sometimes take their students earlier than the regular pick-up time. When you need to do this, please sign out your student on the purple Early Release sign-out sheet at the office and we will call the classroom to ready your child. It is also a good idea to alert the teacher when there is a change in schedule.

### People picking up your student:

Every student starts with only their primary caregivers on their pick-up list. These are usually the people who enrolled the child. If you need someone else to pick up your child - whether on a regular schedule or just once - we ask you complete this [Authorized Pick-up Form](#). If you did this last year, that information does not get transferred to this year's roster. We will need you to give us the contact information for your child's other adults again. Teachers are not allowed to release a child to a person who is not on that student's authorized list. We appreciate your cooperation.

## TalkingPoints

We've partnered with TalkingPoints to help keep you informed with what's going on at the EEU!

Download the app now to start communicating with the admin and classroom teams. If you do not download the app, you can still receive messages about school closures and large announcements.

Additional Pathways Park beverages will be available.


**Accessibility:** Pathways Park has an accessible portable bathroom.
